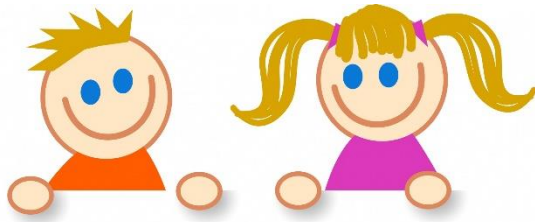

Update from Tina Connors Councillor – New Ross (District 6)

Earlier this month I participated in the spring conference of the Federation of Nova Scotia Municipalities – a professional development training event for municipal councillors and senior staff. The annual event, held virtually, took place on May 6 and 7. Topics for this session included: Office of Regulatory Affairs and Service Effectiveness; asset management; rural economy issues; collaborative municipal success stories.

Budget 2021-2022: The budget for 2021-22 was approved at the May 13 Council Meeting. Deliberations started mid December with each municipal department presenting to Council priority projects and cost figures. The final budget reflects financial priorities for the upcoming fiscal year, as well priorities that align with our Strategic Plan.

The Operating Budget for 2021-22 is \$28,270,935 and the Capital Budget is \$7,718,316. Tax rates will remain the same, with residential at \$0.705 and commercial at \$1.53.

A substantial portion of our annual budget – our share of Mandatory Provincial Payments – automatically goes to the Province. For 2021-22 this amount equates to approximately 63.5% of our general tax revenue (28.5% of our total revenue). Mandatory or non-discretionary provincial expenditures include such things as: education; RCMP & correctional services; library services; and more.

All budget information is available to the public.

Sherbrooke Lake Public Access Update: The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg (MODL) has not begun development of Sherbrooke Lake Park as of yet; Council (MODL) did not allocate any funds to the project during their recent budget approvals for 2021-2022. The public access site is accessed either from Walden, or Mahone Bay.

Did You Know: *Community Wheels* is a community-based transportation service for residents of the Municipality. It offers rides to appointments and medical services, as well as for grocery shopping, recreational programs, banking and other activities. Payment for the service within the Municipality is 'pay what you can'. (Destinations outside of the Municipality include a suggested donation amount.) Community Wheels started in 2007 with one used van and now operates a 14-passenger, wheelchair-accessible mini bus, two wheelchair-accessible 4-passenger vans, and an economical passenger car. The service was initiated by like-minded support organizations with the idea to complement private transportation operators. Community Wheels is also licensed to provide charter service at set fees. All revenue earned by charters is used to support the 'by donation' service.
