


Bart Hencie Hiltz





Update from Tina Connors Councillor – New Ross (District 6)

A quick reminder to community organizations that the annual deadline for the *Municipal Recreation Grant Program* is October 7. Contact the Recreation Office at 902-275-3490 with any questions.

Another quick reminder... the semi-annual deadline for *Council and Tourism Grants* – available to organizations – is coming up! Current application deadlines are twice-a-year, with the second-round deadline October 31.

Grants to Organizations: Staff and Council are doing a 'check-in' of all municipal grant programs, taking the time to look at what's been working

well, along with areas for improvement and suggested changes. Workshop discussions have focused on: grant categories, including possible new program(s); eligibility criteria; and deadlines.



Municipal Boundary Review 2022: Every eight years, all municipal units in Nova Scotia are legally required to conduct a Municipal Governance & Electoral Boundary Review, with the last review taking place in 2014. Municipalities must submit an application to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (NSUARB) by December 31, 2022 with a recommendation and rationale for confirming or changing the number of councillors and the boundaries of polling districts.

The UARB provides broad guidelines for adjusting polling district boundaries and several factors are taken into consideration, such as: the number of electors; relative parity of voting power; population density; community of interest; and geographic size. Representation is essential to how municipal government functions, with councillors elected from polling districts to serve the interests of those specific areas as well as the Municipality as a whole. Ensuring the voting power of electors is effective, fair, and representative is the ultimate goal.

More information, along with a resident survey, can be found online - voicesandchoices.ca/boundary - as well as in the September/ October issue of our municipal newsletter, *Municipal Insight*. Any changes that result from the review will be in place for the next municipal election in 2024.

Don't Forget: The Municipal Recreation Department offers all non-profit groups in our municipality 100 free photocopies per year (that is, 100 black & white *or* 50 colour). As well, there is an equipment-loan program that includes such items as: data projector; projection screen; flip charts; folding tables; sandwich boards; pylons; canopy tent (10x10); PA system with microphone; walkie-talkies; GPS units; bull horn. And more fun things too, like: washer toss; monocular; binoculars; Kelly Kettle; snowshoes; igloo maker! If interested in finding out more, contact the office at 902-275-3490/recreation@chester.ca.

October 1st & 2nd By The Light of the Candle

In the early 1800's the only source of light would have been by candle. Many families would have had to make their own candles or else go with no light at all. Come join staff in making candles just like the settlers would have done years ago.

October 8th & 9th




