It's also a place where anyone can donate those same items. It's open whenever our office is open, Monday – Thursday, 8:00am – 4:00pm. We can not guarantee anything being 'in stock' or know when/if it will be back. Come help yourself and us, by using this free food service.

Some Programs & Services that can be offered when needed: Pre/Post Natal (individual or small group sessions to learn about pregnancy, childbirth, meet other new parents), Rainbows (emotional healing among children, grieving from loss or life-altering crisis), and Nobody's Perfect Parenting Program (open to all parents/caregivers of children age birth to 5 years, helps parents/caregivers recognize their own strengths and to find positive ways to raise healthy, happy children, building on what they already know and do for themselves and their children). Home Heating rebate forms are available here. As well as help filling out other Government grants for seniors or relief with Hurricane Fiona.

COMING SOON - AMP-ed UP!! An anger management program for those to gain knowledge and help manage challenging situations. It will cover topics such as the cycle of anger, triggers & cues, how anger affects our body and impacts our relationships. We will also discuss the role communication plays in healthy relationships. If this is something you would be interested, please reach out to us so we can get a group set up ASAP.

PARENTING JOURNEY PROGRAM: Parenting Journey is a FREE, voluntary program that helps to strengthen relationships between children, parents/caregivers, family members and their community. Parents/Caregivers are welcome to refer or any service provider can assist with a referral. 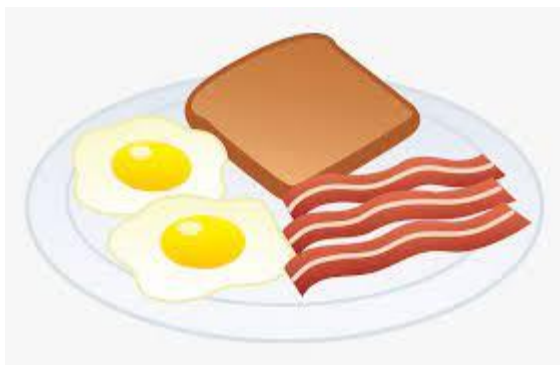

Christmas In the Country Dec 3rd & 4th

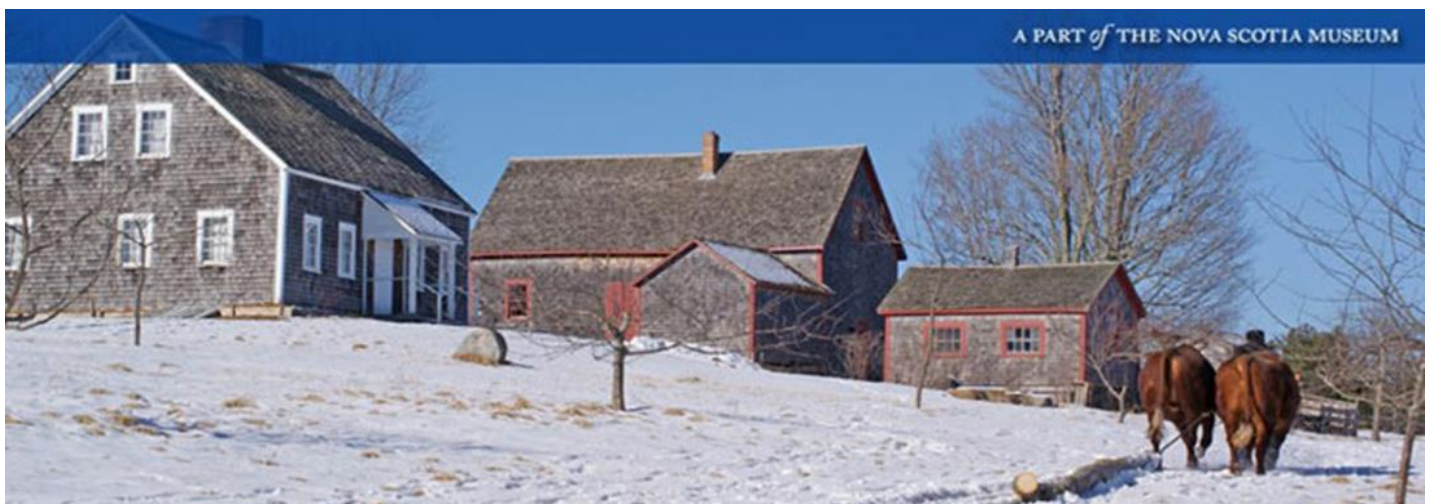

# Update from Tina Connors Councillor – New Ross (District 6)

The 2022 Annual Conference of the Federation of Nova Scotia Municipalities took place November 1 - 4, in Halifax. Municipal Councillors and senior staff from across Nova Scotia came together for discussion, to learn from each other and from subject matter experts. This opportunity gives participants a way to expand their knowledge about a variety of matters to improve representation for constituents.

**Municipal Tax Exemption:** Do you qualify for a property tax exemption? You may IF: the total income from all persons who have an interest in your property (listed as owners or co-owners or who contributes to household expenses) was less than \$29,590 in the 2021 calendar year; the property is your principal dwelling (the principal dwelling of one of the listed owners). The exemption is based on total income, and applies to the residential and waste collection portion of your property tax.

The deadline to apply ('received' at the municipal office), for the current taxation year, is March 31, 2023. Contact me with any questions.

## **Recent Discussions at Council Table:**

- > Hubbards Community Plan - presentation by UPLAND Consulting, re: Hubbards Streetscape Report, including active transportation improvements and overall community development;
- > Safe Walking Signs - a *Safe Community Walking* Program has been approved (modelled after Hike NS signage program), along with *Safe Cycling*;
- > Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Program - a new By-Law (No. 154) and new Policy (P-111) have been introduced to enable the Municipality to provide low interest financing to qualifying homeowners interested in undertaking clean energy upgrades.

**Don't Forget:** Nova Scotia EMO - Emergency Management Office - and the Red Cross recommend that you keep a disaster preparedness kit in your home with enough supplies to meet your family's needs for at least 72 hours. Being ready for any type of disaster makes good sense. A basic kit would include such items as: non-perishable food; manual can opener; water; crank or battery-operated radio; flashlights; batteries; extra keys (house and vehicles); first-aid supplies; medication for everyone for 3 days; a plan for pets (as well as food & medications); and make sure to have some cash in smaller bills.

**Municipal Awareness Week** - November 21 to 27, 2022 - This public awareness week aims to "shine the light on" municipal government in Nova Scotia. The idea or intention of *Municipal Awareness Week* is to: promote the importance of municipal government in peoples' daily lives; encourage citizens to participate in municipal government; and increase voter turnout rates during municipal elections.

There are 49 municipalities in Nova Scotia, ranging in land size/geographic coverage and population, including Towns (25), Counties (9), Regions (4), and Districts (11). The District of Chester is 1,120.61 km<sup>2</sup>, and based on the nos. from the 2021 census our population is 10,693!

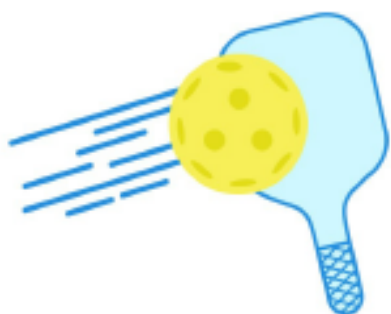

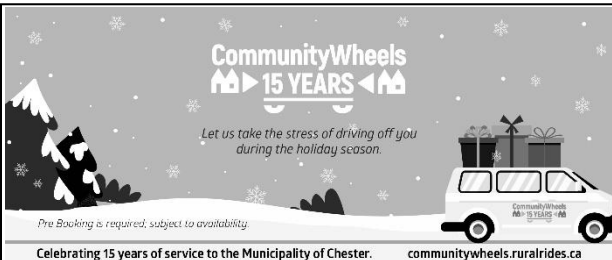
