## Make a bucket! Basic coopering workshop at Ross Farm Museum!

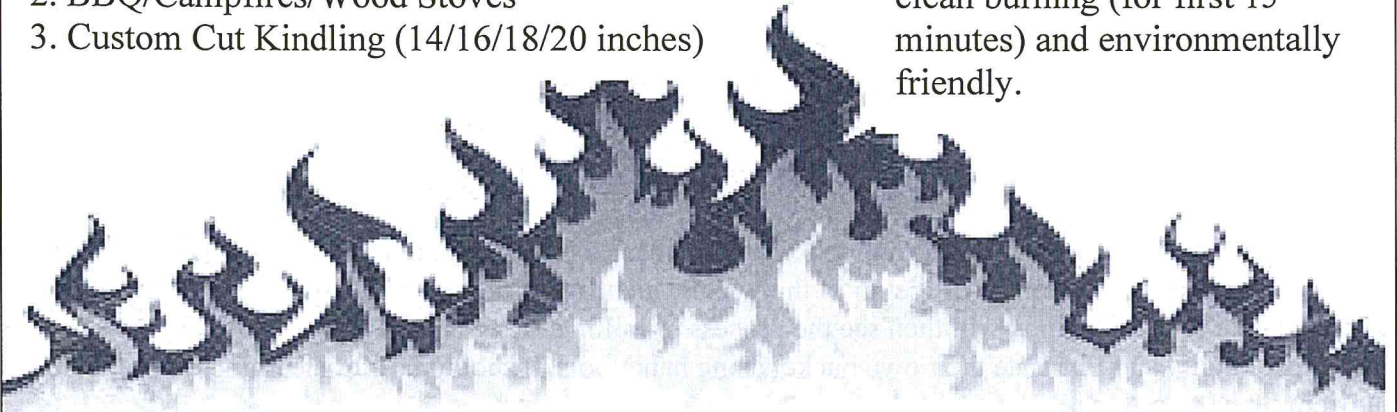

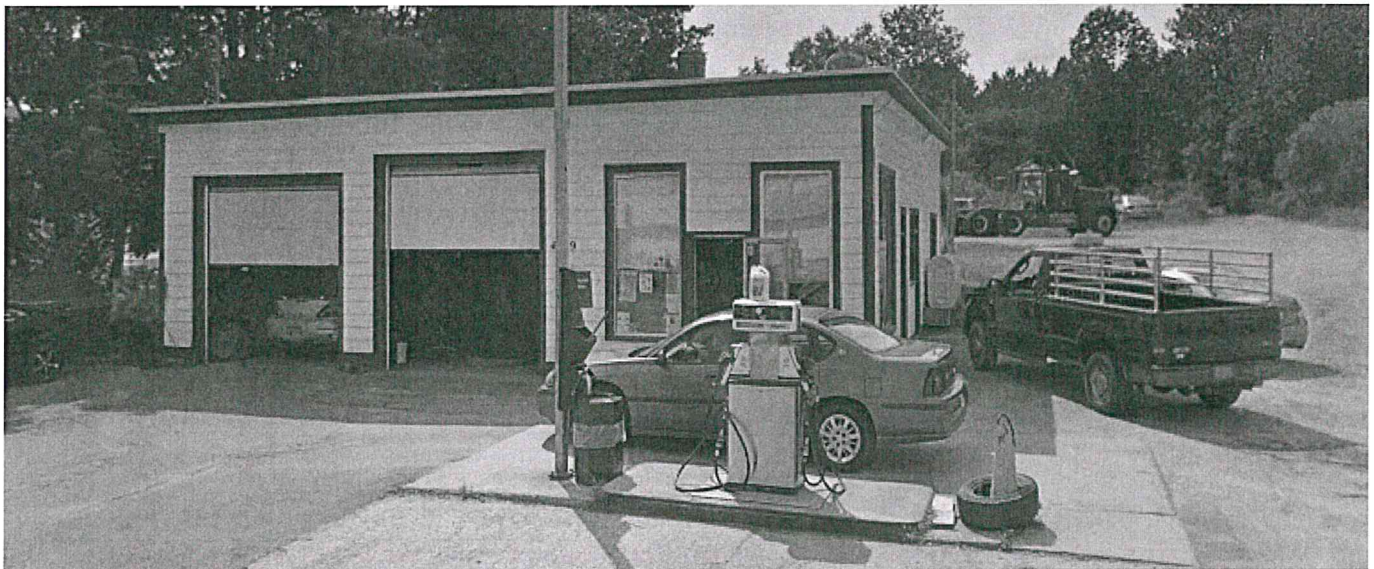


## Did you know...

We've spent the winter planning for the year ahead. After putting most of our events on hold for the last couple years, we're planning to make use of our post and beam pavilion and host more on-farm events this year. We hope these events are of interest to both folks here in New Ross and also attract people to our community. Online registration and payment will be available on our website for each event. Although we're still working on fine-tuning details and dates, here's what we have planned so far:

**Forest Bathing Wellness Walk (April 24)** – Join us in the forest here on the farm with Wil Bruner, Certified Forest Therapy Guide and founder of Soft Pine Wellness for a 2-hour forest bathing and wellness walk experience. To read more about forest bathing and Soft Pine Wellness, check out their website ([www.softpinewellness.ca](http://www.softpinewellness.ca)) or reach out to us directly. Cost is \$40 plus tax per person, or \$70 plus tax per pair/couple. Deadline to register is April 21.

**Dahlia Tuber Planting Demo (May 14)** – If you're interested in growing dahlias, Christina has a limited number of surplus (no-name) tubers to share. She'll provide some details on planting and growing and dahlias supply 2 free tubers per participant. Stay tuned for registration details on this **free** event.

**Herb Planter Workshop (May 28)**- Plant your own take-home herb garden in a large planter. Participants will learn about growing and caring for herbs in containers, harvesting and preserving herbs. All supplies and take-home information provided. Limited to 10 people. Cost is \$45 plus tax per person.

**Plant & Seedling Sale (late May/early June)**- Each year, Christina grows a couple dozen varieties of tomatoes/peppers/herbs and sells "extras". This is an easy way to include new varieties in your garden.

**U-Pick Lilacs (June)** – Date to be determined based on weather and bloom time. Pick your own bouquet of lovely smelling purple lilacs to take home. Pruners to cut your blooms and glass jar/water provided.

**Photography Day (July)** – A day where we invite photographers of all skill levels, including inspiring/amateur photographers to the farm to take photos and socialize. This is a **free** event.

**(Guided) Garden U-Pick (August/September)** - Inspired by our garden tours offered during Open Farm Day each year, we're offering (by appointment only) a guided garden tour where participants get to pick (or get us to pick for you) a basket of produce, herbs and flowers that you would like to take home.

**Open Farm Day (September 18)** – Hold the date for this **free** event.

**Bouquet Making Workshop (September 10 and 17)** – Join us and our friends from Foraged Florals for a 2-hour flower experience and bouquet making workshop featuring Christina's farm-grown dahlias.

**Christmas Tree U-Pick (December)** – we will be hosting our annual Christmas Tree U-pick.
