#### Update from Tina Connors Councillor - New Ross (District 6)

**Budget 2025-2026:** The budget for 2025-26 was approved at the May 5 Council Meeting. Deliberations started mid December with each municipal department presenting to Council priority projects and cost figures. The final budget reflects financial priorities for the upcoming fiscal year, as well priorities that align with our Strategic Plan.

The Operating Budget for 2025-26 is \$33,132,626 and the Capital Budget, \$47,383,101. Tax rates will remain the same, with residential at \$0.685 and commercial at \$1.50.



#### A few things to note:

- o total residential property assessments up 5.1%; total commercial property assessments down 2.2%;
- o residential properties that fall under the Capped Assessment Program (CAP) in N.S. saw an assessment increase of 1.5% or less [\* the CAP does not apply to commercial properties nor does it apply to any improvements (made) to a 'capped' residential property];
- o 79.9% of Chester Municipality residential property assessments increased by 1.5% or less.

A substantial portion of our annual budget includes 'mandatory or non-discretionary expenditures'. Mandatory contributions include provincial services, such as: RCMP & correctional services; education; library services; and more. For 2025-26 this amount equates to approximately 60.2.% of our general tax rate.

All budget information is available to the public.

**Did You Know:** Community Wheels is a community-based transportation service for residents of the Municipality. It offers rides to appointments and medical services, as well as for grocery shopping, recreational programs, banking and other activities. Payment for the service within the Municipality is 'pay what you can'. (Destinations outside of the Municipality include a suggested donation amount.) Community Wheels started in 2007 with one used van and now operates two 14-passenger, wheelchair-accessible minibuses, one 4-passenger, wheelchair-accessible van, one 7-passenger van, one 4-passenger or 1-passenger + 1 wheelchair-accessible car, and one 4-passenger car. The service was initiated by likeminded support organizations with the idea to complement private transportation operators. Community Wheels is also licensed to provide charter service at set fees. All revenue earned by charters is used to support the 'by donation' service.
