

League of Alumni – Call to Ross Farm Museum Alumni and Crafters



Thank you to the many persons from this community and beyond who helped in various ways through care, prayer, and moral support.


To the awesome Lunenburg County Home Support girls who over the past seven years grew to be like family and replaced the absence of other family members.
