CVITP (Community Volunteer Income Tax Program)

Mona Thomarat has been approved by CRA to complete simple Income Tax returns again this year. The program will be available after February 24th, 2026.

Criteria is as follows:

Income threshold increased,
Family size - 1 person - \$ 40,000.
2 persons- \$55,000
3 persons - \$60,000 etc

Eligible:

Modest income
Simple tax situation - Employment T4's, pension, CPP, OAS etc

Not Eligible:

-self employment
-rental income
- capital gains / losses
-Interest income over \$1,200
- Deceased taxpayers
