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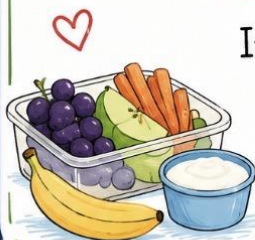

TURBINE DELIVERY UPDATE



Phase 2 of the Benjamins Mill Wind Project (3 Turbines) (aka Minas Highlands Wind Project)

Construction activities for the 3-turbine phase 2 of the Benjamins Mill Wind Project, also called the Minas Highlands Wind Project (the Project), are scheduled to continue through the summer and fall of 2026. This 3-turbine Project will be owned by Minas Basin Wind Limited, a partnership between Natural Forces and Minas Basin Pulp and Power. The Project is located in West Hants Regional Municipality 14 km southwest of Windsor on the same site as the 8-turbine Benjamins Mill Wind Project, which is now operational.

Delivery of turbine components is planned to take place from early September through mid-October, with two main sets of deliveries (see attached map with delivery routes):

- Tower sections (oversized loads) are planned to be transported overnight, departing Port of Halifax at approximately 2:00 a.m., starting around the second week of September.
- Blades (oversized loads) are planned to be transported during the day, departing Port of Liverpool between approximately 10:00–11:00 a.m., starting around the third week of September.
- Other turbine components (regular loads) are also planned to be transported during the day, departing Port of Liverpool between approximately 10:00–11:00 a.m., starting around the third week of September.

The deliveries will require traffic management across LUN346 Rocky Brook Bridge on New Russell road, which will be reduced to one lane and will have a temporary traffic light. More detailed delivery information will be posted on a weekly basis on the Project website, and each oversized load will have live tracking available, as detailed below. All transport activities are being carefully planned to minimize disruptions.

2. Enter these login credentials:

3. Once logged in, select "Map" on the left-hand side panel to view locations of components travelling in real time.

Note: If you see an orange "Warning" sign in the Asset list, it is not necessarily indicative of the device not working. It is likely showing that because the GPS tracker is not moving due to the vehicle being stationary.

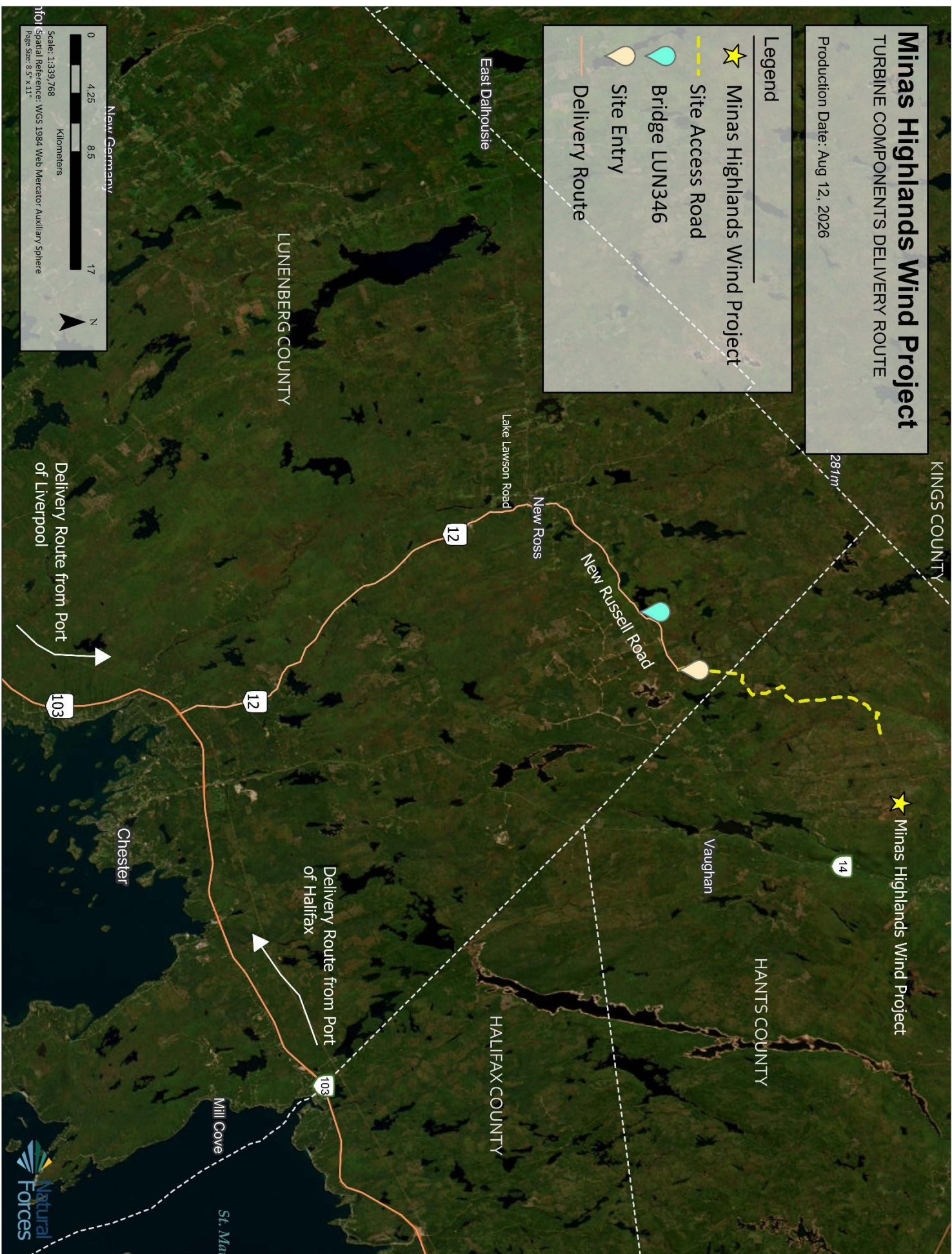

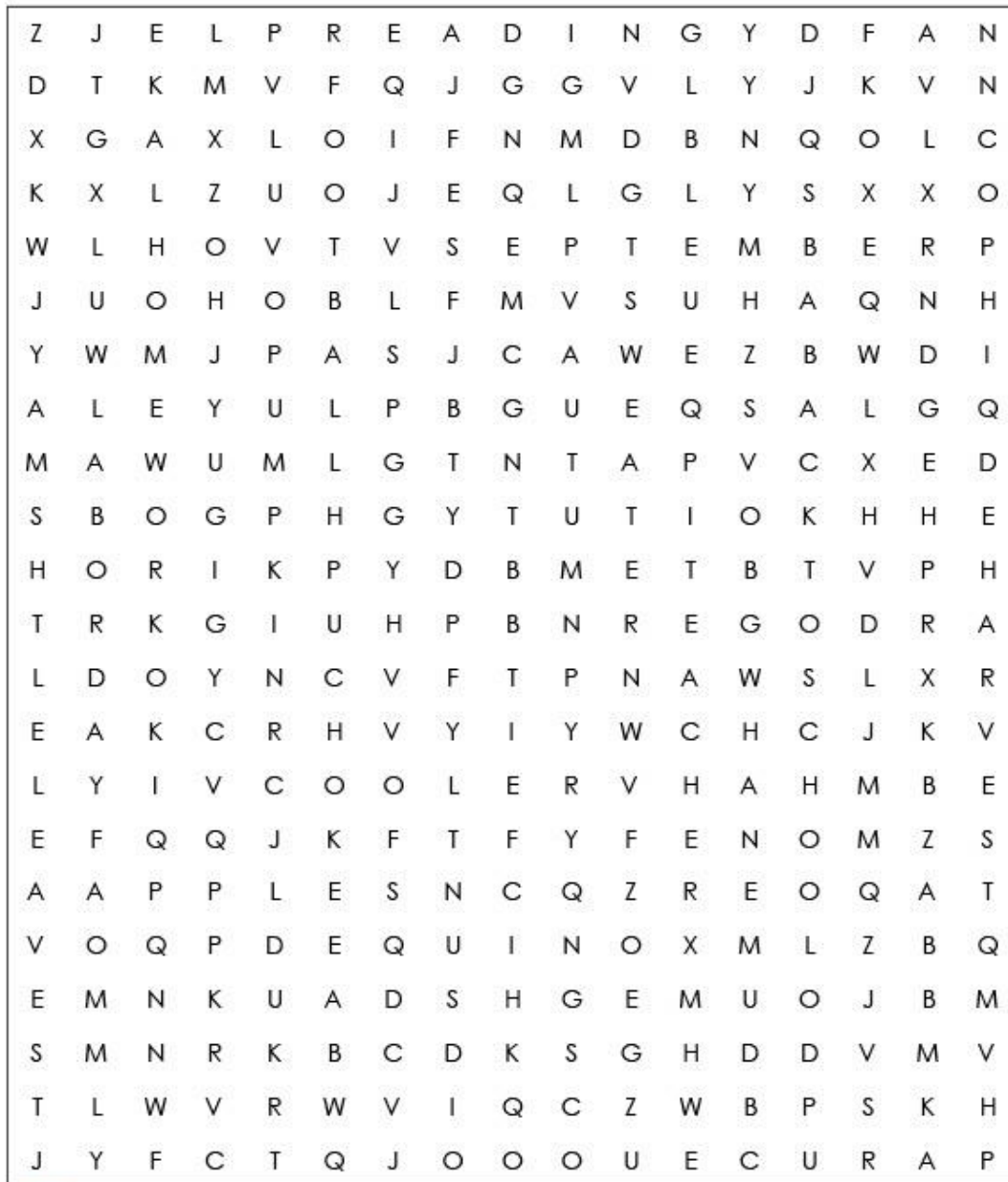
